Requirements	* It would be waived for the students from English medium institutions.
	* If the student does not have the score of English language proficiency level,
	the certificate issued by home university's language center is possible.
	The Certificate or letter should be submitted during the application process
	$\cdot$ The student will study at GIST for a semester and pay tuition fees to their home university.
	* If GIST agrees, the student can study for up to two semesters.

## Accommodation Dormitories are free for all exchange students. (Bedding rental is USD \$20 per month/ optional) (Cleaning fee is USD \$38 per student/ mandatory) • The room is for 2 people, furnished with beds, closets, desks, and chairs. (blankets and pillows are not included) Shared facilities include restrooms, showers, study rooms, washing machines, clothes dryer, and a lobby.

· All types of heaters and cooking equipment are not allowed.

### VISA, Health Insurance, etc.

VISA	• All applicants who are not Korean need a visa to study in Korea. In order to get a visa, you must apply for one with the original certificate of admission issued by GIST at the embassy or consulate of the Republic of Korea in your home country.
	* The certificate of admission will be sent to the student on early June 2024.(via mail)
Health Insurance	• GIST does <b>not</b> provide any insurance for exchange students. Also Korean National Health Insurance is mandatory for the international students who are staying 90days or above(\$50/month). There are few exceptions in countries. All incoming exchange students must acquire health insurance that covers them during the full duration of their stay overseas either private or KNHI. Details will be announced to the applicants.
Alien	$\cdot$ As an international student, it is essential to issue an Alien Registration Card(ARC) to stay in
Registration	Korea for more than 90 days.
Arrival Dates / Orientation	· The Student should arrive <b>one week before</b> the beginning of the semester.
	· The orientation by the GIST International advisor will be proceeded.
	· GIST offers Korean Language courses.
Bank	·To create a bank account, it is needed to issue an Alien Registration Card(ARC).
	Usually, it takes 2 months after your arrival in Korea.
