GUIDELINES FOR THE AUTHOR(S) OF ABSTRACTS

The abstract should consist only of text prepared within a single paragraph, describing the content of the planned speech but not literally. The abstract should not contain any graphical elements such as tables, graphs, photographs, diagrams, etc. The content of the abstract should be formed based on the IMRAD scheme. It should include introductory information, describing the research topic and its purpose; methodology, listing the most important research methods and techniques leading to the result (in the case of a systematic review paper, literature review methodology); results, description of the most important results, conclusions and implications of the research; summary and discussion, a brief commentary on the obtained results, a summary of the overall effect of the work, optionally its probable effect on future scientific work. The abstract should not include citations or literature references. The abstract should be written in English or Polish. If the presented content was created as a result of a project or research grant, please include information in italics below the abstract according to the scheme: "The research was developed under the project/grant name [project code]/[grant number])." Project/grant information does not count toward the word limit.
