GUIDELINES FOR THE AUTHOR(S) OF ABSTRACTS

The abstract should be submitted as an attachment to the submission **in doc/docx or PDF format file entitled Abstract_Name_Surname**. The abstract should consist only of text prepared within a single paragraph, describing the content of the planned speech but not literally. **The abstract should not contain any graphical elements such as tables, graphs, photographs, diagrams, etc.** The content of the abstract should be formed based on the IMRAD scheme. It should include introductory information, describing the research topic and its purpose; methodology, listing the most important research methods and techniques leading to the result (in the case of a systematic review paper, literature review methodology); results, description of the most important results, conclusions and implications of the research; summary and discussion, a brief commentary on the obtained results, a summary of the overall effect of the work, optionally its probable effect on future scientific work. **The abstract should not include citations or literature references. Please use Times New Roman font size 12 with bottom, top, left, and right margins of 2.5 cm; 1.5 times spacing, and please align the text. The abstract should be written in English or Polish.** If the presented content was created as a result of a project or research grant, please include information in italics below the abstract according to the scheme: “The research was developed under the project/grant name [project code]/[grant number].” Project/grant information does not count toward the word limit.
